The tool lets users view group cultural profiles in multiple, customizable ways, and allows the creation of additional cultural dimensions beyond 17 standard dimensions that already cover a wide spectrum (e.g., time management, definitions of identity, organizational arrangements, communication patterns, modes of thinking, etc.). The COF assessment goes hand in hand with broad, inclusive and dynamic concept of culture.

You will explore your own individual and collective COF profiles, discuss how these may affect your work and discover new developmental avenues. Philippe will also share examples and best practices from his 25+ years international experience in individual and team coaching, as well as in organizational development (notably in the cases of alliances and mergers & acquisitions).

This experiential workshop will combine interactive presentations, individual reflections, peer coaching, intercultural coaching demonstration and group discussions.
